

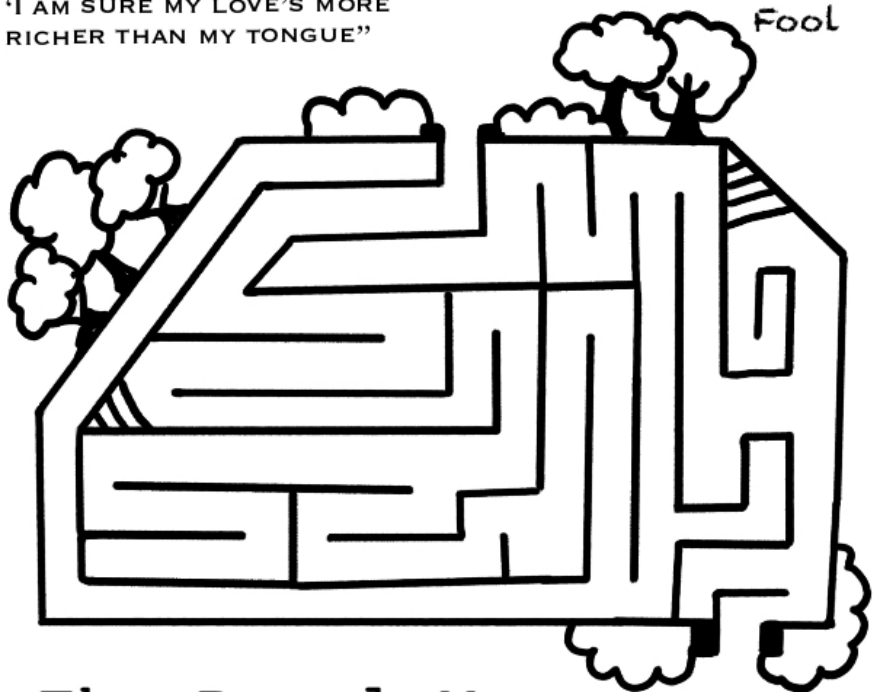


Did you know!?
